Wem Carnival Safety Rules.

Due to new legislation regarding Health & Safety issues, we are obliged to issue advice to all entrants. Please therefore read and take note of all the points listed below then sign and return a copy of this document with your Parade Entry Form.

Adhering to these instructions will ensure we all have an enjoyable Carnival Day.

Instructions to Float/ Trailer Entrants

IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT DRIVERS OF VEHICLES ARE AWARE THAT THEY ARE LEGALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SAFETY OF THEIR LOAD WHETHER IT BE PASSENGERS OR DECORATIONS AND COULD FACE PROSECUTION BY THE POLICE IF THE LOAD IS DEEMED UNSAFE. WE ASK THAT YOUR FLOAT MARSHALLS ARE VIIGILANT AND LIASE WITH THE DRIVER AT ALL TIMES. Example: a child sitting along the edge of the float is an unsafe load. Action: the vehicle should be stopped and the child moved to safety.

General Advice.

1. All vehicles and trailers must be fit for use on the public highway with a current MOT Certificate, appropriate vehicle insurance and be correctly taxed.
2. Nobody should embark or disembark from the float whilst the engine of the vehicle is turned on.
3. Floats must assemble on Pymms Road, **NOT** Thomas Adams Access Road.
4. The Access Route to the Carnival Gala Field should be kept free of obstruction at all times to ensure emergency vehicles are able to gain access or exit.
5. No part of the vehicle or float theme will exceed 14'6" above floor level.
6. Any themes using powered moving parts or danger zones should be adequately guarded.
7. Ensure that no-one is standing or seated around the edge of the float.
8. Young children on floats should be seated and adequately supervised by an adult.
9. Ensure that no objects can fall over or off the float and that no objects (including water, confetti or sweets) are thrown into the crowd.
10. Smoking and consumption of alcohol on floats is strictly prohibited.

The Carnival Committee reserve the right to refuse entrance to the Carnival if the rules are not adhered to and the entrance fee will be non returnable.
